

**The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 153
Scholarship Information (Revised 12/15/2004)**

Purpose/Criteria:

The International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers, Local 153, Scholarship provides scholarship support to biological or dependent children (as determined by the IRS) including step-children who live more than 50 percent of the time in the household of active union members in good standing who are contributing to the Electrical Industry Advancement Fund. If insufficient applicants are gathered from this group, IUSB will consider biological grandchildren and then current spouses (in that order) of active union members in good standing.

Applicants must be formally admitted to IUSB and can pursue study in any IUSB undergraduate degree program, including associate and bachelor degrees. Full or part-time, as well as beginning and transfer applicants will be considered.

Amount:

The scholarship will award up to 30 percent of the per credit hour tuition cost of attendance at IUSB as well as a book stipend. The book stipend award will be calculated at \$10 per credit hour up to \$153.00.

Application Process:

Candidates must submit the following items by March 15:

1. A completed scholarship application (attached)
2. Most recent High school and or college transcripts, if applicable.
3. A 500 to 750 word essay discussing the impact and benefits labor unions have provided them and their families.

Recipients will be selected on the basis of previous academic record and analysis of the submitted essay. Scholarships will be announced by April 30 and awarded the following Fall term.

Renewal Criteria:

Scholarships may be renewed after the first year of attendance if the scholarship recipient maintains satisfactory academic progress by maintaining a 2.0 (C) GPA. Recipients will be awarded the scholarship for the reasonable amount of time needed to complete their degree program if they remain active as a part for full-time student. Renewal applicants must submit a letter describing academic progress throughout the year and a current transcript indicating maintenance of the 2.0 GPA requirement.
